## **AN UPDATE FROM JANET AND PETER DALLMAN IN JAPAN**

We begin by saying a huge 'thank you' for your many, many encouraging e-mails to us in this difficult time. We remain well and life in Hokkaido continues as normal - except that there is now petrol rationing in place all over Japan. All OMF missionaries in Japan are safe, though some in Sendai have lost possessions - including a car, which was washed away. Many are also suffering 'rolling blackouts' and some have little water or gas.

At the moment, OMF Japan is not recommending that we evacuate the country, but some colleagues may choose to re-locate within Japan or to their home countries. Sapporo is about 350 miles from the nuclear plant in Fukushima, and we are unaffected by that or by the earthquake & tsunami, so at the moment, we are not considering evacuation ourselves. However, it may be that we receive some of those who choose to re-locate to Sapporo. The situation changes by the hour and so most things are uncertain. Meanwhile, we continue to try to fulfil God's call on our lives, by running JLC and helping students with life and language study in Sapporo, in order to reach many lost Japanese for Christ. It is hard to concentrate, both for us and for the students, but other than pray, there is little else to do at the moment, but continue with the work God has already given us.
