DAILY READINGS

We take a break from reading Matthew this week since we have a visiting preacher next week. However, the daily readings continue as follows:

Monday: Genesis 12:1-7 - God's promise to Abram (Abraham) - Jesus is Abraham's Son in Matt 1:1

Tuesday: Genesis 17:1-17 - God gives greater detail regarding his promise to Abraham

Wednesday: Galatians 3:1-22 - Jesus as the fulfilment of the Old Testament Law and the promises to Abraham

Thursday: 1 Chronicles 17:1-15 - God's promise to David - Jesus is David's Son in Matt 1:1

Friday: Psalm 72 - God's blueprint for the extent and nature of the rule of the king (David's Son)

Saturday: Psalm 89 - A pointed questioning of God's promises to David given Israel's experience of exile - yet, 'how long' expects an answer from God that is faithful to his promises.

Sunday: Acts 2:22-36 - Jesus shown to be the fulfilment of God's promises to David.
