**DEACONS ELECTION**

**APPEAL RESPONSE FUND**

Following the storm damage across the Caribbean, the Deacons have sent £600 from the Appeal Response fund to Haiti Hospital Appeal. In addition, £400 was donated to Christian Vision for Men a month ago to help them with a specific financial crisis appeal.

**OFFERINGS IN SEPTEMBER 2012**

Against a target offerings of £14,228 per month (which includes the New Manse Fund regular donors) we received £16,047 in September. As an average, this puts us marginally above our rolling budget target which may enable us to pay back personal loans quicker. Praise God, and thank you.
