## August Finances

Gifts & Offertories across the General Fund and New Manse Fund in August amount to £14,756 against our budget of £15,338 and so we were £582 under budget in August. This equates to 3.79% under budget. However, year to date from April, we budgeted £76,690 and have received £79,571 and so we are about 3.7% ahead of budget.
