This morning's service will last around an hour and a quarter. We worship together with our children and young people for the first part of the service and then they will leave for their own activities - if you are not sure where to go, follow the crowd out to the Middle Hall and someone will direct you to the right group. An audio loop system is installed, for anyone downstairs wearing a suitable hearing aid.

Several Small Groups meet during the week on various days and in various locations. There is a list of all small groups on the noticeboard in the welcome area, or speak to Andy Banks.


Mike and Sue Stean
